PETITION FOR CONSIDERATION OF NON-AFFILIATED STUDY ABROAD PROGRAMS

Dear Student:

In an effort to facilitate the equivalency process for NIU Cosponsored study abroad programs* and to streamline the application process for students, our office strongly encourages students to choose from study abroad programs that have been vetted and approved by the NIU Study Abroad Office.

The goal of the NIU Study Abroad Office is to provide a range of affordable study abroad programs that meet the many academic needs of our students. All NIU study abroad programs must meet standards of academic and administrative integrity, as well as student safety. Each program must be evaluated according to these and other criteria by the staff of the NIU Study Abroad Office.

The program you are considering is not among those which have been determined to have met the standards required for approval by the NIU Study Abroad Office. Before your application to study on this program will be considered, you are required to complete this *Petition for Consideration of Non-Affiliated Study Abroad Programs*. This completed petition and supporting documentation must be provided to our office by you **no later than 6 weeks prior to the application deadline** for the program you are asking our office to consider. Notification regarding our decision will be communicated to you within fourteen (14) days of submission of the completed *Petition*.

If your *Petition* is approved, you may start an application at <u>http://niu.studioabroad.com</u>. Once on the web site, search for the program named <u>Petition</u>. Should you receive notification that your Petition has been declined, alternative program options and application information will be provided to you.

IMPORTANT NOTES

By submitting this petition, petitioner grants consent to the NIU Study Abroad Office to request petitioner's unofficial transcript and other documentation which may be necessary to determine petitioner's basic eligibility for study abroad participation. **Petitions submitted by students who do not meet basic eligibility requirements will be denied.** NIU's study abroad eligibility policy can be viewed on our website: <u>http://www.niu.edu/niuabroad</u>.

It is your responsibility as petitioner to ensure that this petition is submitted in its complete form. Official documentation from the study abroad program provider or its website addressing the subject of each question on the following pages must be included *with this petition*. Supporting documentation must be clearly marked with the number of the question to which it applies. The NIU Study Abroad Office reserves the right to deny your petition solely on the grounds of incomplete, inadequate, unmarked or late documentation.

If your *Petition* is declined and you choose to participate on a study abroad program without the assistance of the NIU Study Abroad Office, any forms provided to you by this office will be rendered null and void, and you may not receive NIU academic credit for coursework completed abroad. You will also be ineligible for guidance and assistance from the NIU Study Abroad Office and for federal and state financial aid.

All decisions made by the NIU Study Abroad Office regarding submitted Petitions for Consideration of Non-Affiliated Programs are final. Appeals will not be considered.
